I used to think that being a saint was boring. And there is part of me that often holds back from the adventure, the drama of Christ's call: "Come, follow me." There is part of me (or most of me) that prefers the safe to splendor.

But my mind has been muddled. And I have been looking at the best things in life as if they would bite. Prayer is not poison. Father Pablo's unfinished painting of B. Pier Giorgio Frassati is in the Saber Café. Frassati, who died at 24, would rise early with his friends to go to Mass at 5:00 a.m. before climbing a summit. He loved the poor, politics, mountain climbing, being light hearted, and Christ and Adoration.

Here is a short story from his life:

Prayer was central to Blessed Pier Giorgio's spirituality. He was often found praying at the foot of his bed. He had rosaries made for his friends and was frequently seen with one in his hand. Once, as he left a church with his rosary in his hand, someone said to him, "So, Pier Giorgio, you have become a religious fanatic?" He calmly answered, "No, I have remained a Christian."
